#### 1. Call to Order.

At the Coalition's August 20<sup>th</sup> meeting, a review of the SLAMM Urban Runoff Model inputs was authorized, up to \$2,000 under the TMDL Services Contract, therefore this outstanding liability may produce a final balance of \$3,008.82 for the TMDL Services Contract.


Action: Stormwater Coalition approved report by consensus.

<u>Discussion:</u> Andy Johnson introduced the history of Farmer Councils and how water quality management has occurred in Wisconsin historically.

- "W ditches" are too efficient at moving water and nutrients to waters of the state.
- Adaptive management and trading will probably need to go through Farmer Councils.
